## FindMe™

FindMe is a form of User Policy, which is the set of rules that determines what happens to a particular user or group when it is received by the VCS.

The FindMe feature lets you assign a single FindMe ID to individuals or teams in your enterprise. When a FindMe ID is dialed, users can set up a list of locations such as "at home" or "at office" and associate their devices with those locations. They can then specify which devices are available when a FindMe ID is dialed, and what happens if those devices are busy or go unanswered. You can support up to 15 devices and 10 locations.

This means that potential callers can be given a single FindMe alias on which they can reach a user or group in your enterprise — callers won't have to know details of all the devices or locations that a group might be available.

To enable this feature you must purchase and install the **FindMe** option key. Standalone VCS's own FindMe manager. However, you can use an off-box FindMe manager; this is a future third-party integration.

## Endpoint traversal technology requirements

The "far end" (at home or at a hotel, for example) endpoint requirements to support firewall traversal are summarized below:

- For H.323, the endpoint needs to support Assent or H460.18 and H460.19.

## Groups and Users

A group or user with access to the Content Server can have one of three roles. Each role has access to different menus in the Content Server. The roles and available menus are as follows:

- **Viewer**—groups or users who can view the recordings they have been given access to. Viewers have access to all recordings. Viewers can also view all recordings with guest access.
- **Creator**—groups or users who can create recordings. When logged in as creators, they have access to all recordings that they have permission to edit. Creators possess all the properties of viewers.

## Understanding Group and User Accounts

Groups and users have to be Windows group or user accounts before they can be added to the Content Server. Adding users to the Content Server depends on whether or not guest access is enabled in **Configuration > Site settings**. You must also consider the authentication mode. The appropriate authentication mode depends on how user accounts are organized in your company:

- You use Active Directory, but your Content Server is not in a domain or is in a different domain from the domain that contains the groups and users. (See [Option 1: Active Directory](#).)
- You use Active Directory, and your Content Server is in the same domain as your groups and users. This option is recommended. (See [Option 2: Domain](#).)
- You do not use Active Directory. This option is the least preferred because it is more time consuming to configure and maintain. (See [Option 3: Local](#).)

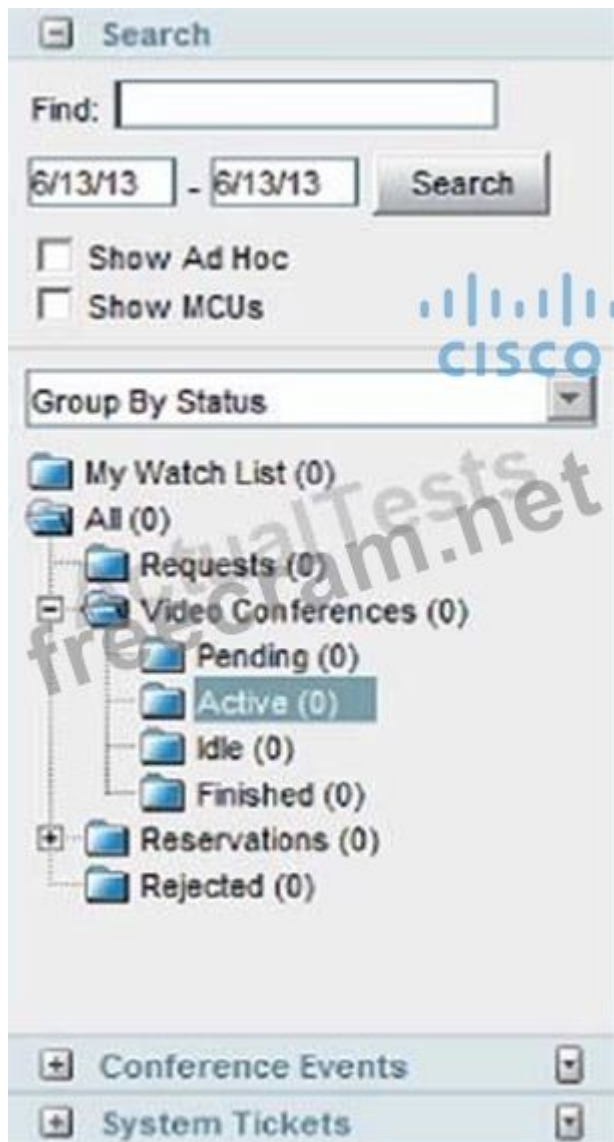

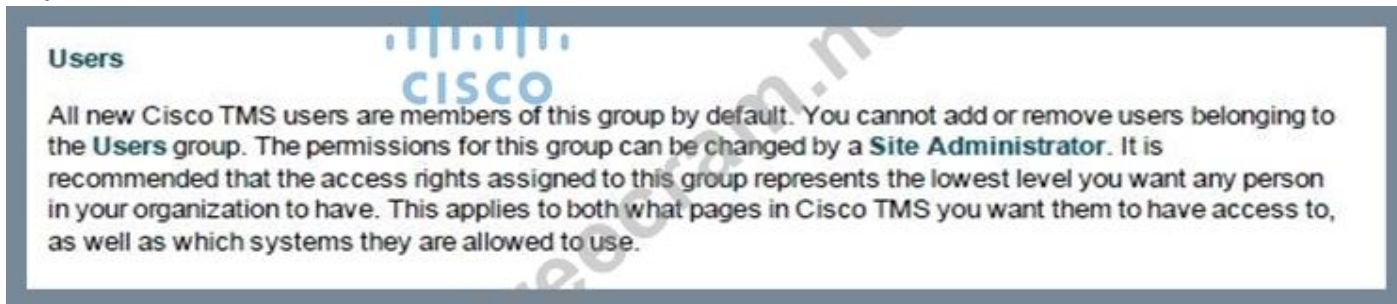

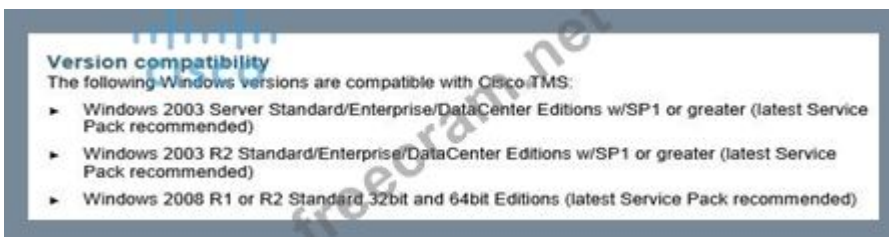
